**IHSAA Chat:** The IHSAA has been in conversation with Direct Athletics to stay the course with meet reporting through DA in track and having the tournament results to be there for cross country. We don't ever want to have things behind a payroll. Direct Athletics has offered things with Meet Pro. MileSplit has now purchased Direct Athletics. We want to keep using DirectAthletics if possible.

-The Track State Finals is moving from Bloomington to North Central. All field events are contained within the stadium and there is also the option to host the jumps inside an adjacent building if needed. The tennis state finals are being hosted at North Central on the same date. There will be eight teams at the tennis state finals.

-There will be a track realignment committee meeting in October made up of coaches and athletic directors from around the state.

Each year we have a new list of members. XC Academic All-State nominations is due October 7<sup>th</sup> and you must be a member to nominate an athlete for Academic All-State. Everything should now be up on the new website but the website itself needs to be working fine. **Mideast CC Meet Report:** The November 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> in Kettering, Ohio. It will once again be a triangular meet with Michigan and Ohio. The biggest issue this year is that the Mideast Meet falls on the same weekend as the Nike meet in Terre Haute. We have mailed out letters to the top 25-30 returning seniors. We have 30+ athletes that have signed up so far, which is typical for this time of year. Paige Brunner can get the information to anyone who needs it.

**2025 Track Clinic-** The clinic will be February 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Thanks to Michael Clements, we are contracted for this year. The A/V costs have increased and we need to make sure we have what we want. Julie Alano will get forms to those who recruit speakers really soon. **Indiana All-Star Track Meet Report:** We will be running the meet on June 14<sup>th</sup>, at Marion University. We will be staying overnight again this year but everything we be at Marion. The date is still a week before the Nike Outdoor Nationals. Terry Lakes is going to step down as our Midwest Meet Coordinator. Let Mike Davidson know if you know of anyone who wants to get involved with planning the Midwest Meet of Champions. Last year we got the awards stand from the State finals thanks to the IHSAA and the Potters. Thanks to Nate Larson for getting all the medals from last year and this upcoming year. We had a very competitive meet and a good-sized crowd. We had a great speaker the night before with an excellent message. The plan is still for the HSR meet to give money to the Midwest Meet. Katie Wise from Marion did a great job of helping us as well.

**HSR:** The Hoosier State Relays will be held on March 29, 2025. Bob Potter has been working really hard at getting sponsorships already for the 2025 meet. Large schools will go first this year. Fall Creek Pavilion will be bringing in more seating and they are hosting the DII nationals there this year. We are the last event in the building. We want to improve on the pole vault, so we want to start the pole vault competition early again this year and limit pole vault entries to top 12 and ties. We are going to try to check poles as teams enter to speed up that process as well.

**Hall of Fame:** The Hall of Fame is still working on the next set of inductees- some have been contacted but we have not publicly announced the next inductees. If you have not been to the Hall of Fame, you need to get over there. We will get out information regarding when they will be open during the weekend of the state XC meet.

**XC Survey:** The results were essentially 50% for the class options and 50% against the options.

**Coaches Education:** Spread the word to remind everyone to complete their coach's education online courses. You won't be able to enter athletes if the coaches haven't completed their up-to-date training videos.
