**Financial Report-** Motion to accept the financial report: Mike Davidson, second- Jared Turner. We are in a healthy financial position right now. It has taken a lot of work over the last few years to get here. We have \$69,000 on hand, with much of that currently obligated to activities throughout the year, with the goal of having \$25,000 in reserve at the end of the year (last year we had \$20,00, so it is good to continue growing). We got over \$30,000 from the clinic.

**Membership & Technology-** We are in a good place, with memberships rolling in right now online to nominate for Academic All-State. Members automatically get on the email list through MailChimp. If you see anything on the website that needs to be addressed, reach out to Julie Alano.

**Midwest Meet Information:** We are still ironing out the plan for 2026 and are trying to figure out the best plan not only for this year, but moving forward. We are still looking into going back to a two-day event eventually, even if it remains a one-day event for this year. Frank Litz has been doing a great job looking into many options, reaching out to Wabash, Rose Holman, and Notre Dame. Wabash could not host this year due to construction. Rose Holman is excited about possibly hosting. Notre Dame is also excited, but cannot make it happen this year because of conflicts with their on-site facilities crew. Michael Clements has estimated that an overnight would cost approximately \$32,000 for the association (this used to be split between three states and only for seniors, but now is all paid by our association and we include juniors as well). Because of this, Michael recommends that we make the All-Star Meet a one-day event again this year, with definitely having the potential for a two-day meet in 2027. Julie Alano stated that it would be possible to have a luncheon for the All-Stars if we have the meet at HSE in 2026. What are other ways we can raise money to consistently make the All-Star Meet a two-day event? Do we need to put together a specific committee for fundraising for the All-Star Meet. Asking for donations from former All-Stars? Using social media to reach out to former All-Stars to donate to the meet. Also, HSR is planning on giving the association \$15,000, which we could use for the All-Star Meet, but we obviously don't want to rely on that every year.

**Clinic Items:** This past year's clinic went well

We will be back at the Sheraton hotel February 4-6, 2027. We are looking at signing for 2028 to save money and lock in at current rates. If you have an idea for a big name speaker, or any speaker ideas, please let Julie Alano or one of the other speaker coordinators know: Mike Davidson, Frank Litz, and Matt Toothman.

**MidEast XC Meet:** November 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> in Kettering, Ohio. We are hopefully financially safe to get the same gear as we did last year (including backpacks).

**HSR Report-** This year's meet was a huge success with a great crowd! The HSR committee will give \$8,000 to the Hall of Fame, and \$15,000 to the IATCCC. We have discussed other ways to use the money to give back. Shoutout to Jared Turner for providing 20+ volunteers from Yorktown! We had a lot of improvements this year, including the sponsor banner and HSR alumni banners, as well as doughnuts and coffee for our officials. The 2027 meet will be held March 27, 2027. Parking was awful for teams this year and we were blindsided by those issues- we will be in touch with the fairgrounds to alleviate that for 2027. The Morales Group wanted to donate \$2,500, but we did not have an updated W-9, so they donated their \$2,500 to the Hall of Fame. We are listed as a non-for-profit through the State, so we will check to make sure everything is good moving forward. There were issues working with MileSplit that we have taken care of for next year. Send ideas for improving the meet to Bob Potter or anyone associated with the meet.

**Hall of Fame:** The ceremony is on June 20<sup>th</sup>, and there is a reception at 1:00 at the Hall of Fame, followed by the banquet at 5:00 at Idle Creek golf course.

**New Business:** We had a group that has been passionate about putting together a proposal for a class system, especially for cross country. We have been in contact with the IHSAA to discuss bylaws and things that might need to be cleared up or changed before putting together our next survey. We also need to discuss with the IHSAA how we make sure the survey gets to every coach. We need to make sure that Sectional entries through MileSplit are limited to performances from the IHSAA season only. We need to report bogus times found on MileSplit to Jane at the IHSAA. We also need to talk to Jane about how meet hosts can change hand times that are currently found on MileSplit when they are forced to populate Sectional entries.
